

Growth Goal Sample Templates

Using a growth goal template, teachers can create goals based on a consistent format. Using the simple examples below, your district can tailor a series of goals that work well for your teams.

Sample Template #1:

Of the students enrolled in (insert course or class name), (insert a goal or range)% of these students will reach their individual student goals, as indicated in the attached spreadsheet, on the (insert name of assessment tool).

Example Using Temple #1

Of the students enrolled in Algebra II, 80% of these students will reach their individual student goals, as indicated in the attached spreadsheet, on the district type II Common Math Assessment Set.

Sample Template #2:

Of the (insert the number of students in targeted group) students in the targeted population of (insert course or class name), (insert a goal or range)% of these students will improve their baseline score by (insert goal improvement amount)% on the (insert name of assessment tool).

**Targeted population must be defined with rationale.*

Example Using Temple #2

Of the 60 students in the targeted population of Grade 7 Mrs. Smith's Art Classes, 75% of these students will improve their baseline score by 25% on the district type II Common Art Rubric Set.

Sample Template #3:

Example Using Temple #3

Of the 60 students in the targeted population of Grade 7 Mr. Jones's Classes, 75% of these students will reach their individual student goals, as indicated in the attached spreadsheet, on the district type II Common Assessment Set.

Sample Template #4:

Of the students enrolled in (insert course or class name), (insert a goal or range)% will achieve (insert expected growth amount) and meet their individual goals as indicated in the attached spreadsheet, on the (insert name of assessment tool).

Example Using Temple #4

Of the students enrolled in Mr. Bell's Social Studies Classes, 75% will achieve 50% of the growth needed to score 100% and meet their individual goals as indicated in the attached spreadsheet, on the common Social Studies Assessment Set.

Sample Template #5:

The average assessment score of students enrolled in (insert course or class name), will improve by (insert a goal or range)% between baseline pre-assessment and post-assessment on the (insert name of assessment tool).

** Note: This template is not helpful for districts setting roll-up scores based on % of students meeting their goals.*

Example Using Temple #5

The average assessment score of students enrolled in Mrs. Smith's English IV, will improve by 25% between baseline pre-assessment and post-assessment on the district Common English Writing Rubric.
