- 5:25 AM** ▪ Mr. Everett, Mr. Schwingle and Mr. Cherry will report their findings and the status of the area roads and parking lots, as well as discuss the past, current and future weather conditions
- 5:30 AM** ▪ Mr. Everett will make one of three decisions
1. School is in session with a regular schedule
2. School is in session with a delayed start
